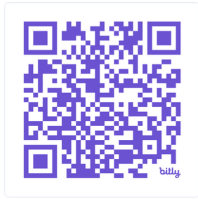

Commissioned by Governor Lachlan Macquarie and designed by Francis Greenway, Australia's first colonial architect, the 1818 Parramatta Female Factory is a testament to Australia's convict past. Approximately 24,960 women were transported to the colony, and it is estimated that one in seven Australians today can trace their ancestry to female convicts.

Discover the Inspiring Stories of the Women. Learn about the struggles, resilience, and acts of defiance of the women who endured life at the Factory. Explore how their experiences and contributions helped shape Australia's cultural and social fabric, leaving a profound legacy that resonates today.
